The students visited the mill namely - M/s Yogendra Worsted Mill, (A unit of Shiva Group), Ludhiana where the students learned the manufacturing process of acrylic yarns. The students also visited Spinning unit of M/s Winsom Textile Industries Ltd., Kaundi village, Baddi (HP) where the students learned the manufacturing process of cotton yarns, and cotton/polyester blended yarns. The students also learned about the management of the mill and got an exposure of the testing and research facilities available in the Research and development department of the mill.

The mill authorities also assured the students for assisting them in research projects by providing the testing facilities.
