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The following points were discussed and decisions taken,

ITEM NO. 01.01: INFORMATION REGARDING 1ST MEETING OF STANDING COMMITTEE OF MRSPTU ACADEMIC COUNCIL HELD ON 20.12.2016

DECISION: The members noted the Minutes of Meeting of Standing Committee of MRSPTU Academic Council held on 20.12.2016 and approved syllabi of 1st and 2nd Semesters for 2016 Batch with the following observations/recommendations that may be considered while finalising syllabi for 1st and 2nd Semesters for 2017

- 1. In the syllabus of every Course in all Programmes, duration of that Course in terms of contact hours may be mentioned at the level of B. Tech. 1st year for 2017 Batch onwards. Further, every Course syllabus (theory) may be equally divided (as far as possible) in four units, with each unit having been allotted contact hours for it.
- 2. Value added Courses, such as, Soft Skills, Environmental Science, Human Values and Ethics may not be given any credits, at the level of B.Tech. 1st year for 2017 Batch onwards. However, it may be mandatory to get pass in these Courses.
- 3. There are mismatching of marks given in Study Schemes of some Programmes for 1st and 2nd Semesters for 2016 Batch. Such Study Schemes be referred back to concerned BOS to make the necessary corrections in it.
- 4. Course of Computer Graphics Lab. may be introduced at the level of B.Tech. 1st year for 2017 Batch onwards and to be taught by Mechanical Engineering Department to provide knowledge of any one of the design software, such as, Autocad, Qcad, Sledworks 2d etc. Decision may be taken in Meeting of Chairpersons of BOSs.
- 5. Engineering Drawing Course (BMEE0-102) may have L T P/1 0 6 in place L T P/1 0 4 at the level of B.Tech. 1st year for 2017 Batch onwards.
- 6. Elements Mechanical Engineering (BMEE0-101) syllabus in B.Tech. 1st year syllabus for 2017 Batch onwards may be designed in such a manner that a single book should cover the whole syllabus. 40% syllabus may be from Thermodynamics and 60% syllabus may be from mechanics. There may not be topics of Internal Combustion Engines and Fluid Mechanics in it.
- 7. There may be a basic Course of Civil Engineering in B. Tech. 1st year syllabus for 2017 Batch onwards. Decision may be taken in Meeting of Chairpersons of BOSs.
- 8. Every UG/PG Course syllabus must include Course Objectives, Course Accreditation.

 9. Text books (3-8) and reference books (1-2) of quauthors may be recommended to cover the wide authors and complete Course contents.

ITEM NO. 01.02: APPROVAL OF SYLLABI OF UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

DECISION: The Syllabi of Programmes contained in the following **Table-I** were approved with the observations/recommendations that,

- 1. Detailed syllabi up to 8th Semester of the following B.Tech. Programmes are to be put up in the 2nd Meeting of Faculty of Engineering & Technology.
 - (a) Electrical and Electronics Engineering,
 - (b) Electrical Engineering,
 - (c) Electronics Engineering,
 - (d) Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering,
 - (e) Electronics & Instrumentation Engineering.
- 2. In the syllabus of every Course in all Programmes, duration of that Course in terms of contact hours may be mentioned. Further, every Course syllabus (theory) may be equally divided (as far as possible) in four units, with each unit having been allotted contact hours for it.
- 3. Major projects should be of allotted maximum 04 Credits.
- 4. Value added Courses, such as, Soft Skills, Environmental Science, Human Values and Ethics may not be given any credits, however, it should be mandatory to get pass in these Courses.
- 5. There may be a Course of Cryogenic Engineering in place of Welding Technology (BMEE1-460) as Departmental Elective-II.
- 6. There are mismatching of marks given in Study Schemes of some Programmes from 3rd semester onwards. Such Study Schemes be referred back to concerned BOS to make the necessary corrections in it.
- 7. There may be Course of CAD Lab. In 8th Semester of. B.Tech. Mech. Engineering.
- 8. Machine Drawing Course (BMEE1-303) using CAD may have L T P/1 0 6 in place L T P/1 0 4.
- 9. Different nomenclature may be there for different Courses of the same Programmes instead of writing -1, -2, e.g., Textile Fibre-1 and Textile Fibre-2.
- 10. Department of Mechanical Engineering may offer more Departmental Electives and Open Electives for UG Programmes.
- Every UG Course syllabus must include Course Objectives, Course Outcomes and Pre-requisite for Programme Accreditation under National Board of Accreditation.
- 12. A Special Chapter heading 'Recent Advances' may be included in all the courses to imbibe newness in courses and students must able to learn the new technological aspects.
- 13. There may be credits assigned to Industrial Training the students undergo during different times in their Degree Program.
