The following decisions were taken:





At the outset, Chairman extended a warm welcome to all the members for sparing their valuable time for making value addition to the architectural & planning education of the MRSPTU, Bathinda.

Chairman informed the members that Standing Committee of the Academic Council of MRSPTU, Bathinda in its 2nd meeting held on 26-2-2018 approved the starting of M.Planning (with an initial intake of 18) and Bachelors of Interior Design course in its 3rd meeting held on 16-11-2018. In order to make the courses operational from the academic session 2019-20, Chairman informed that the study scheme for the M.Planning and Bachelors of Interior Design needs to be finalized before making the courses operational. Chairman further informed that draft scheme for these courses have been prepared. The draft schemes were presented to the members and after detailed discussions, the following decisions were taken:

1. The Masters in Planning will have specialization in Urban Planning and accordingly the degree awarded to the students after completion of the course shall be Masters in Urban Planning.

Further, it was agreed that the scheme prepared by AICTE for the M.Planning (Urban Planning) shall be adopted with minor modifications. Accordingly, Board approved the scheme of study for Masters in Urban Planning alongwith detailed contents as indicated in the Annexure A.

2. In case of Bachelors in Interior Design, the draft scheme prepared by the Department was discussed in detail and was approved with modifications.

It was further decided that the detailed contents of the scheme shall be prepared and circulated to all members for approval within a period of 3 weeks. The approved scheme for the Bachelors in Interior Design course is placed at Annexure B.

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


3. The Board also discussed the issues related to the B.Arch. syllabus presently in operation and approved the following:

The following issues were discussed and recommendation made for approval:

1. Students of 7th sem.(2017 Batch) have requested to postpone their 6 months Practical Training to July-Dec.2021(9th sem.) instead of Jan. – July 2021 (8th sem.) due to the ongoing Pandemic. In this matter all parents are reluctant to send their wards to different places for Practical Training. Moreover the Architectural Firms are not willing to hire Trainees during this period. So, considering all the facts & the ongoing situation of COVID, it is suggested that the practical training for the B.Arch (2017 batch) which is scheduled from Jan-July, 2021 can be shifted to 9th semester (July-December, 2021). This would be a one-time change only due to the Covid situation. In lieu of this 9th sem.subjects/scheme will be followed in 8th sem. Approval may be sought from Dean, Academic Affairs for this. All issues related to this will be resolved by COE.
2. During admission 2020 for PG courses, it has been noticed/ Observed that most of the aspirants want to pursue part time M.Arch as most of them are already working in various firms. So, it is suggested that Part time M.Arch should be started from the next session (July, 2021).
3. The issue regarding calling the students into the campus for Viva-voce has been discussed and in the same context both online/offline mode will be offered. For this, it was also decided that the local students can be called for physical mode. For this, subject in charge/ class co-ordinators are advised to contact the willing students for the same.

Ar. Gaurav Raheja, Professor IIT, Roorkee, was not able to attend the meeting due to some other engagement.

Dr. Bhupinder Pal Singh Dhot extended warm welcome all the members followed by the commencement of agendas of the meeting (Annexure 1).

AGENDA: 1a

Ar. Mitakshi Sharma unfolded the scheme of proposed new course – Bachelor of Interior Design and the course curriculum was discussed. BOS members came up with following suggestions;

- All members agreed to eligibility criteria for the course as 12th or diploma with minimum 40% marks in any stream and students intake to be 30. Also conduct of entrance test to course was proposed by one member, but most of the members were in favor of admission on merit basis.
- Prof. Rajni suggested to shift subjects of Digital Graphics from 3rd to 1st or 2nd semester finding it more appropriate. She also mentioned to continue Model Making subject in further semesters too rather than to teach in 1st semester only, for which all members agreed.

- Ar. Jit Kumar Gupta recommended to revise the load of L.T.S.P in the proposed scheme for B. Interior Design.

All members have approved this course, its overall structure and study scheme for all 4 years, with recommendation to make minor modifications in the contents of syllabus.

AGENDA: 1b

Dr. Bhupinder Pal Singh Dhot made B.O.S. members acquainted with the another proposed course, BFA- Applied Arts and the expert Mr. Gurpreet Singh (Artist) to deliberate about the scheme and the curriculum of the course. Following considerations have been made by the members.

- Mr. Gurpreet initiated with objective of the course, i.e. to make students capable of performing well in Industrial Jobs followed by discussing the proposed scheme for the course with the whole team.
- The Eligibility criteria was finalized to be 12th or Diploma with minimum 40% marks in any stream and students intake was finalized to be 30.
- Members recommended either to club or to reduce the subjects of 1st semester. Also, workshops and expert lectures by professionals should be conducted timely throughout the course to strengthen the learning.
- Studio timings should be devised out in a manner to dedicate 2-3 studios to single topic to emphasize continuity of the topic.
- Ar. Jit Kumar Gupta advised to add theories of 'Ram Singh' in the subject- 'Art Forms of Punjab' in 2nd semester along with other authors.
- Dr. Jatinder Kaur proposed to merge subject- "Advertising Art & Ideas" with any of the studio subjects so that to intensify the essence of the subject.
- Subject of Photography is decided to be taught in any further semester than in 1st semester so that students from other courses can also join to enhance their skills.
- Ar. Jit Kumar Gupta recommended to arrange exchange programmes and industrial visits to boost up students learning of the course. He also suggested to incorporate word "Arts" in the name of our department i.e. GZS School of Architecture and Planning.
- Experts suggested to advertise BFA and B. Interior Design along with B.Arch to attract admissions as our institute is the only one to offer these courses in the Bathinda region.
- During further discussion, Ar. Jit Kumar Gupta suggested to increase the credits and contact hours for core subjects of the course curriculum.
- Ar. Rimpesh Sharma proposed to improvise changes in our teaching pedagogy to sharpen the presentation skills among students.

All members have approved the proposed course along with the study scheme after minor modifications. Members also approved the contents of first year of BFA and suggested some changes/modifications in syllabus for further years.

AGENDA: 1c

The third proposed course, BFA- Animation & Film Making was then introduced. The expert Mr. Eklavya Sharma threw light on the importance of the course and discussed the course curriculum.

- Ar. Rimpesh Sharma suggested not to run this course as presently the experts to run the course are not available with GZSSAP. Therefore, BOS members suggested to run it as one year Certificate course in 'Graphic and Video Editing' rather than a four year degree programme in order to check the admission response.
- Syllabus of the course have to be revised as per new proposal and the same should be sent to all members for approval.

AGENDA: 2

- Prof. Rajni pointed out that exit policy of 1 year certification is not appropriate for B. Interior Design and should be discussed, but most of the members have approved the same keeping in view National Education Policy.
- Ar. Ripu Daman Singh suggested to use nomenclature as "Exit Certificate" in place of "Certificate" only, being more relevant to 1 year certification.
- Following Exit Policy for new courses has been finalized considering the new education policy as follows;
 - For B. Interior Design: Student will get Certificate after 1 year, B.Sc. Interior Design after 3 years and Bachelor of Interior Design (B. Interior Design) after 4 years.
 - For BFA- Applied Arts: Student will get Certificate after 1 Year, Diploma after 2 years, Advanced Diploma after 3 years and BFA- Applied Arts after 4 years.
 - Also the fee structure has been devised out as;
 - i) For B. Interior Design: as per the notification No. DAA/MRSPTU/Notifications/2019/56 dated 14/05/2019.
 - ii) For BFA- Applied Arts: it was recommended to follow the same fee structure as of B. Interior Design.

- Members recommended the practice of new job recruitment and promotion norms as per the Gazette Notification with No. CG-DL-E-11082020-221073 dated 11, August 2020 of Government of India about 'CoA- minimum Standards of Architectural Education Regulations 2020'. (Annexure-II)






