



1. The term of Chairperson and members shall be for a period of two years.
2. The term of Special Invitee shall be for a period of one year.
3. The quorum for the meeting including the Chairperson, but excluding the special invitee, shall be three.
4. In considering the grievances before it, the SGRC shall follow principles of natural justice.
5. The SGRC shall send its report with recommendations, if any, to the competent authority of the institution concerned and a copy there of to the aggrieved student, preferably within a period of 15 working days from the date of receipt of the complaint, as per the procedure set specified under above regulations of UGC.
6. Any student aggrieved by the decision of the Students Grievance Redressal Committee may prefer an appeal to the ombudsperson, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of such decision. This order issued with the approval of the Higher Authority of the University.
