SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION OF CARRYOVER PROVISION NOTIFIED BY THE PHARMACY COUNCIL OF INDIA FOR EXISTING B.PHARM. STUDENTS ADMITTED UP TO THE BATCH 2025.

The Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), vide Letter Ref. No. 14-154/2025-PCI dated 23.07.2026 (Annexure-I), has notified a carryover provision for students admitted up to the Academic Session 2025–26 in the B.Pharm. programme. This provision is intended solely to help students meet the minimum attendance requirements and complete the programme under the regulations applicable to their admission. Furthermore, the PCI has placed the responsibility on the University/Institution to ensure that students admitted under the B.Pharm. syllabus (2016–17) complete the programme as required.

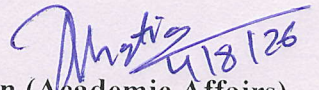
In compliance with the above notification, the following provisions are hereby notified:

- The notification DAA/MRSPTU/2024/4506 dated 20.05.2024 and the subsequent clarification issued vide DAA/MRSPTU/2024/4917 dated 19.08.2025 stand suspended with immediate effect.
- Students admitted under the 2016–17 syllabus are permitted to progress to the next higher semester and attend classes, irrespective of backlog courses.
- Students with attendance shortages may make up the required attendance through special classes or additional instructional hours. The respective institution shall be responsible for making the necessary arrangements.
- Students detained in all courses and required to take readmission to the odd semester of the academic year under CBCS–2016 Clause 10(a) are permitted to be promoted to the next semester.
- Students who failed to register or attend classes in the previous semester are permitted to be promoted to the next semester. However, they must formally apply for Course Continuation to the University and obtain permission as per the rules.
- Students detained from promotion to the 5th semester under Letter No. DAA/MRSPTU/2024/4506 dated 20.05.2024 are permitted to register in the 5th semester after obtaining formal Course Continuation permission from the University.
- Students may carry forward their backlog courses and continue in this manner up to the Eighth Semester.

These provisions are applicable only to students admitted to the B.Pharm. programme up to the Batch 2025. The implementation of the aforesaid provisions shall remain subject to any subsequent clarification, amendment, or direction issued by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI).

The revised B.Pharm. syllabus (2026) as per NEP 2020, prescribed by the PCI, shall be applicable to students admitted from the Academic Session 2026–27 onwards.
